CLASS FULL

This course is an intensive hands-on training program that will prepare students to respond to confined space emergencies. The course provides information in identifying confined spaces and permit-required confined spaces, the hazards associated with permit required confined spaces, target industries and hazards, state and federal regulations, components of a rescue operation, and the roles and responsibilities of rescue teams.

The course will include a selection of manipulative drills. Students Must bring to class the following Personal Protective Equipment: safety-toed boots, helmet (structure, brush, or Tech Rescue type), brush pants and jacket, and eye protection.

Knee and elbow pads are optional.

Cancellation Policy
