This course provides information on advanced heavy rescue system techniques.

Key topics include: Structural building types, wood and mechanical shores, crib capacities, floor weight calculations, building search, confined space considerations, damaged structure hazard assessment, use of small power tools, air bags, and USAR ICS.

PREREQUISITE: * RS-1, Basic ICS
Certificate must be received in training prior to the start of class.

Students must come to class each day with the following personal protective equipment: Long pants, long-sleeved shirt or brush jacket, safety-toed boots, rigging or utility gloves, eye protection, and helmet (tech rescue, brush or structure).
