This course is intended to provide training for fire
service

personnel in water rescue techniques. Topics include: Swift
water rescue, submerged vehicles, drowning, use of engine/truck
company equipment for water rescue, use of rafts and boats, and
water search and recovery. The course emphasizes safety of
rescue personnel.

Each student **MUST** have the following equipment to participate in
the class: a full wet or dry suit, wet suit booties or sneakers, a wa-
ter rescue, climbing or kayaking type helmet (light weight and able
to drain water easily), Type III or Type V personal flotation device,
River/Diving gloves or snug leather gloves. Swim fins are optional.

Code of Conduct: Appropriate dress for class is required. It is the student’s responsibility
to maintain a clean, neat and professional appearance. Some courses may require the
wearing of uniforms or special attire. Course coordinators and/or course announcements
may specify either a style or type of dress for a specific course.
