**CLASS FULL**

This course is designed to train fire service personnel in hands-on application of the techniques necessary to safely affect a rescue from an excavation or trench collapse.

Topics include: Critical considerations while responding to trenching emergencies, evaluation of collapse scenes, basic life support procedures and temporary protection for victims and rescuers, specialized tool usage, shoring techniques, and below grade rescue safety procedures.

Students must come to class each day with the following personal protective equipment: Long pants, long-sleeved shirt or brush jacket, safety-toed boots, rigging or utility gloves, eye protection, and helmet (tech rescue, brush or structure).

**Dear Trench Rescue course enrollee,**  
The Trench Rescue course you are currently enrolled in will now be held on May 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> only, and will not include May 11<sup>th</sup> as originally planned.
